

**WORLD PEACE:

General Description of Entry**

1. Each Louisiana student, either individually or as part of a group, is invited to take part in World Peace Day activities by submitting an entry describing his/her vision and ideas of World Peace through art, essay, music, poem, picture or video. If chosen, the entry may be displayed at the State Capitol Building during September 27 to October 25, 2009, with the Ghandi, King, and Ikeda: A Legacy of Building Peace Exhibit.
2. The entry is not to contain any offensive or obscene references, connotations, gestures or language.
3. Due to space limitations, we can accept no more than one (1) entry per student or group.
4. Each student submitting an entry must submit a completed Entry Form and Parental Permission Form. (see attached)
5. Entries may be submitted the following ways:
